## How to Get to NaCoMe

From Belle Meade, take Highway 100 west for 47 miles to Centerville. Continue on through the Public Square of Centerville, and stay on Hwy 100 for 12 more miles and there should be a sign that says "NaCome – ¼ mile". Turn right on NaCoMe Road (County Rd 1833). The Camp is 2 miles down the narrow country road on the right.

OR

Take I-40 West out of Nashville to exit #172 for Dickson and Centerville. Turn left off the interstate, and follow Hwy 46 for 7 miles to Hwy 100. Turn right and follow Hwy 100 west 18 miles to the Public Square of Centerville. Stay on Hwy 100 for 12 more miles and there should be a sign that says "NaCome – ¼ mile". Turn right on NaCoMe Road (County Rd 1833). The Camp is 2 miles down the narrow country road on the right.

OR

Take the Natchez Trace Parkway to the Hwy 50 Exit. Turn right and travel west toward Centerville. Turn left onto Hwy 100 for about 11 miles and there should be a sign that says "NaCome – ¼ mile". Turn right on NaCoMe Road (County Rd 1833). The Camp is 2 miles down the narrow country road on the right.
