About Hymn 232

It seems likely that this beloved Easter text began in Latin and moved through German before reaching English, where it combined with the present tune in the emerging English evangelical style, a reaction to the restrained onenote-per-syllable psalmody that preceded it. TEXT: Stanzas 1-3, Lyra Davidica, 1708; stanza 4, Charles Wesley, 1740; MUSIC: Lyra Davidica, 1708; adapt. from The Compleat Psalmodist, 1749.

About the Kyrie

The Kyrie (Greek "kyrios" [Lord]) is a corporate musical prayer for grace.

Assurance of Pardon

A declaration of forgiveness proclaims the good news of God's mercy and offers the assurance of pardon in Jesus' name. The liturgist pours water into the font, which reminds us of the grace and cleansing of our Baptism, and the baptismal call to new life in Christ.


Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. It is right to give our thanks and praise.

Philip Stopford has written a joyous anthem for Easter which abounds with energetic alleluias. A very singable melody and an air of celebration with brass accompaniment make this anthem a perfect way to celebrate Easter. The text was written by a Bohemian Brethren pastor, Michael Weisse, in the early 16th century and translated into English by Catherine Winkworth in the 19th century. Winkworth is well known for her English translations of German hymns; her translations are polished and yet remain close to the original.
