The Prelude is a musical offering to help move the hearts and minds of the gathering community from the daily struggles of life to the worship of God.

The Season of Easter

"Easter" comes from an old English word related to dawn and shining. At Easter, we stand in light of the resurrection to see a new creation, transformed by the grace and glory of God. We celebrate the presence and power of the risen Christ, proclaiming the good news through Word and Sacrament. We rejoice in the gift of the Holy Spirit, who is the "Lord and giver of life." In the fullest sense, Easter is a new way of life, in which we are "dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus." (Rom. 6:11).

The Resurrection of the Lord is the center of the Christian year, and the good news we proclaim on this day is the very heart of the gospel. Easter refers not only to a single day, but to a whole season of celebration in the Christian year. The Season of Easter spans the fifty days between the Resurrection and Pentecost, and encompasses the Ascension of the Lord. In this most joyful season, we celebrate the great mystery of our faith - that Jesus Christ is risen from the dead.

About Hymn 232

It seems likely that this beloved Easter text began in Latin and moved through German before reaching English, where it combined with the present tune in the emerging English evangelical style, a reaction to the restrained one-noteper-syllable psalmody that preceded it. TEXT: Stanzas 1-3 Lyra Davidica, 1708; stanza 4, Charles Wesley, 1740; MUSIC: Lyra Davidica, 1708; adapt. from The Compleat Psalmodist, 1749.

About the Kyrie

The Kyrie (Greek "kyrios" [Lord]) is a corporate musical prayer for grace.

Assurance of Pardon

A declaration of forgiveness proclaims the good news of God's mercy and offers the assurance of pardon in Jesus' name. The liturgist pours water into the font, which reminds us of the grace and cleansing of our Baptism, and the baptismal call to new life in Christ.

Act of Praise

The Act of Praise brings together the choir and congregation to sing God's praise in response to the Assurance of Pardon as the last phrase.

Scripture

About Hymn 238

This Easter text, first in French and later in English, was written to fit the music, a chorus created for Handel's oratorio Joshua and moved to Judas Maccabeus in 1751. It grew widely popular following its use at the First Assembly of the World Council of Churches in 1948. TEXT: Edmon Louis Budry, 1884; MUSIC: George Frederick Handel, 1748.

Ye choirs of New Jerusalem, an anthem for Eastertide, was completed in December 1910 and published the following year. The text is taken from the hymn by St Fulbert of Chartres and made famous through H J Gauntlett's hymn tune 'St Fulbert' in Hymns Ancient and Modern. Stanford's anthem is based entirely on original material which alternates between two contrasting thematic ideas, one in the major mode in a lilting triple meter ('Ye choirs of New Jerusalem'), the other in the minor and in quadruple meter ('Devouring depths of hell their prey').
