#### *About the Prelude*

The Prelude is a musical offering to help move the hearts and minds of the gathering community from the daily struggles of life to the worship of God.

#### *The Season of Easter*

"Easter" comes from an old English word related to dawn and shining. At Easter, we stand in light of the resurrection to see a new creation, transformed by the grace and glory of God. We celebrate the presence and power of the risen Christ, proclaiming the good news through Word and Sacrament. We rejoice in the gift of the Holy Spirit, who is the "Lord and giver of life." In the fullest sense, Easter is a new way of life, in which we are "dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus." (Rom. 6:11).

The Resurrection of the Lord is the center of the Christian year, and the good news we proclaim on this day is the very heart of the gospel. Easter refers not only to a single day, but to a whole season of celebration in the Christian year. The Season of Easter spans the fifty days between the Resurrection and Pentecost, and encompasses the Ascension of the Lord. In this most joyful season, we celebrate the great mystery of our faith - that Jesus Christ is risen from the dead.

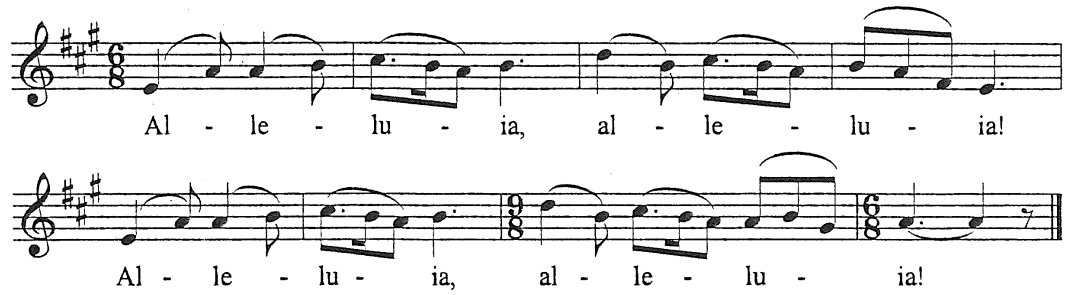

*Assurance of Pardon*

A declaration of forgiveness proclaims the good news of God's mercy and offers the assurance of pardon in Jesus' name. The liturgist pours water into the font, which reminds us of the grace and cleansing of our Baptism, and the baptismal call to new life in Christ.

The Act of Praise brings together the choir and congregation to sing God's praise in response to the Assurance of Pardon as the last phrase.

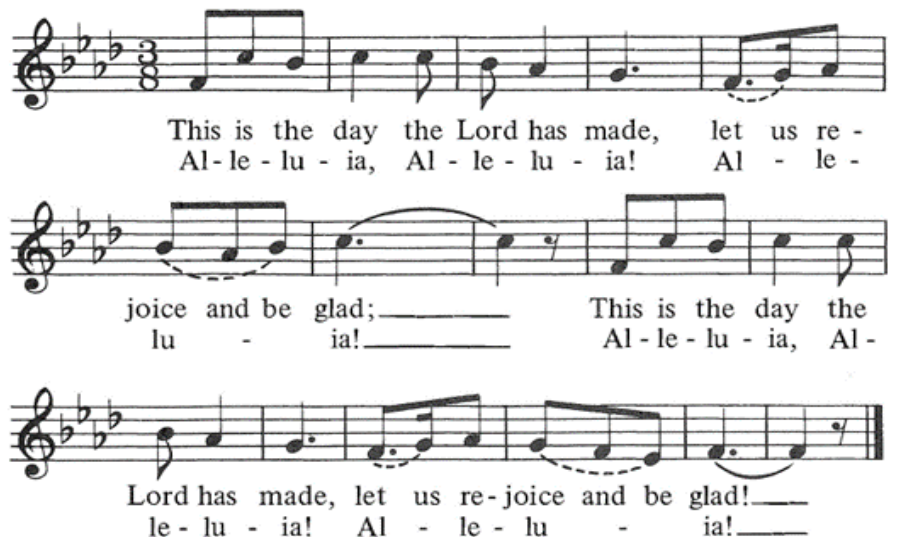

*About the Anthem:  
Christ the Lord Is  
Risen Again*

Philip Stopford has written a joyous anthem for Easter which abounds with energetic alleluias. A very singable melody and an air of celebration with brass accompaniment make this anthem a perfect way to celebrate Easter. The text was written by a Bohemian Brethren pastor, Michael Weisse, in the early 16<sup>th</sup> century and translated into English by Catherine Winkworth in the 19<sup>th</sup> century. Winkworth is well known for her English translations of German hymns; her translations are polished and yet remain close to the original.

Following the offering and preparation of the table, the pastor invites worshipers to the Lord's Supper using scripture, leading the people in a prayer to the triune God: giving thanks for God's creative power, providential care, and covenant faithfulness, along with particular blessings of the day; remembering God's acts of salvation through Jesus' birth, life, death, resurrection, ascension, and promised return; calling on the Holy Spirit to draw worshipers into the presence of the risen Lord, nourish them in the body and blood of Christ, unite them with Christ in the communion of saints and Church in every place, and send them in mission to the world.

In commenting on this late 20th-century text, the author has stressed his intention to affirm the social implications of an Easter faith: "Christian peace and justice action finds its wellspring, not in moral zeal or guilty conscience, but in the resurrection. TEXT: Brian Wren, 1984; MUSIC: Ludwig van Beethoven, 1824.
