

New York Times Best-Selling Author Jane Lorenzini. The author will discuss her latest book, <u>The Growing Season</u>, at the Westminster Café. Jane's book is second in a series set in early Ft. Myers, Florida, and continues the story of Belle Carson and a host of other lovable, quirky characters.

This is Jane's second appearance at an Authors Roundtable at Westminster. She discussed her debut novel, <u>After the Rain</u>, shortly after its release in 2019. She has been a great friend to beginning writers in the Joy in Learning creative writing workshop called *Telling your Story* by consulting with individuals as well as speaking to a class session.

Jane has written four best-selling books with her dear friend, Hoda Kotb, so-host of NBC's Today show. She and Hoda have remained close after working together years ago in TV news in Ft. Myers. According to Hoda, "Jane's writing will charm your heart and tickle your funny bone."



This Authors Roundtable will also introduce Sam Owen, who began writing about his Mississippi boyhood in the Telling Your Story workshops. Sam's delightful stories have become a book titled, <u>Old Times Not Forgotten</u>: As Told by a Son of the South.

Sam and his wife Judy are long-time members of Westminster. He is busily at work on his second book about his love of Ole Miss, meeting Judy, and playing football on championship teams in the early 1960s.

CROWDED TABLE EVENT A SUCCESS!

A wonderful group met to learn more about Westminster's partnership with Crowded Table on Wed., April 28th in the Café.





What is Crowded Table?

It is a nonprofit that works to increase and sustain support for foster families in Middle Tennessee by partnering churches with foster families.

A group of church volunteers, or a Table Team, provide practical support to the foster family, which can include weekly meals, groceries twice a month, laundry, lawn care, and other needs based on an ongoing and intentional relationship.

We Learned:

- Tennessee has the highest rate of instability in foster care in the nation. This means that children in foster care are changing placements frequently.
- According to the State of the Child in Tennessee, of first-time foster children entering the system in 2022, more than 30% had been in three or more placements that first year.
- If a child has more than 3 caseworkers, his or her chance for permanency is less than 13%.

What is a Table Team, and why are they important?

While the numbers are staggering and heartbreaking, *Crowded Table's* mission of walking alongside foster care families and their caseworkers provides churches with a practical way to support and surround these children with love. When a foster family is supported, they are more than 90% likely to continue fostering. Westminster currently has a Table Team in place of about 20 WPC members.

What are Comfort Bags?

We partnered with My Bag My Story and Tennessee Alliance for Kids to pack duffle bags for children. Often, when a child is either removed from a home or transitioning between placements, they can take no more than what fits in a grocery sack. Through support from Joy in Learning and individuals, Westminster has filled 6 bags for the current area of highest need: girls ages 1-3.



PAINTING CLASS THANK YOU!



A HUGE thank you to Rene Poe for instructing a threehour 6-week beginning and a 6-week intermediate class this spring!

The \$50.00 supply fee started the workshop off to a great start. Each participant was surprised with a new set of paints, brushes, pallete paper and canvases. Besides learning many painting techniques with communal and individual paintings, the participants also learned how to take care of their supplies.

Another wonderful gift? They were able to bring their supplies home to continue painting! A beginner commented that she now has an easel set up in her garage and is inviting more friends to join the classes when they are offered again.
