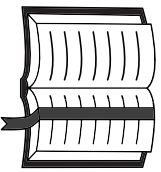
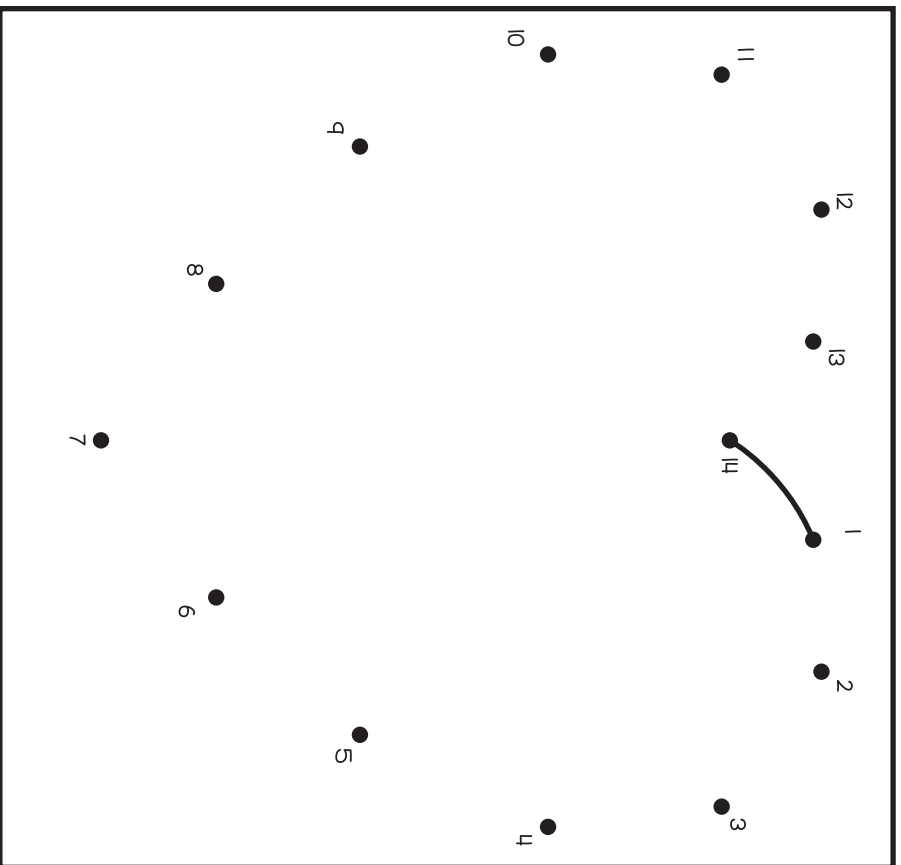


CONNECT the DOTS
